This pattern template is for use with 2 different fabric cuts instead of a single fold in the video. The rest of the steps are the same.

(extra - use for "bias tape" cuts)

Tips:

- If you use the **same piece of fabric** for both sides of the mask, you can get 8 of these masks with a 1yd cut.

- The "bias tape" cuts can be cut in halves (not pictured). The final width of your pleated masks in this case should be 4" or ~3.75"

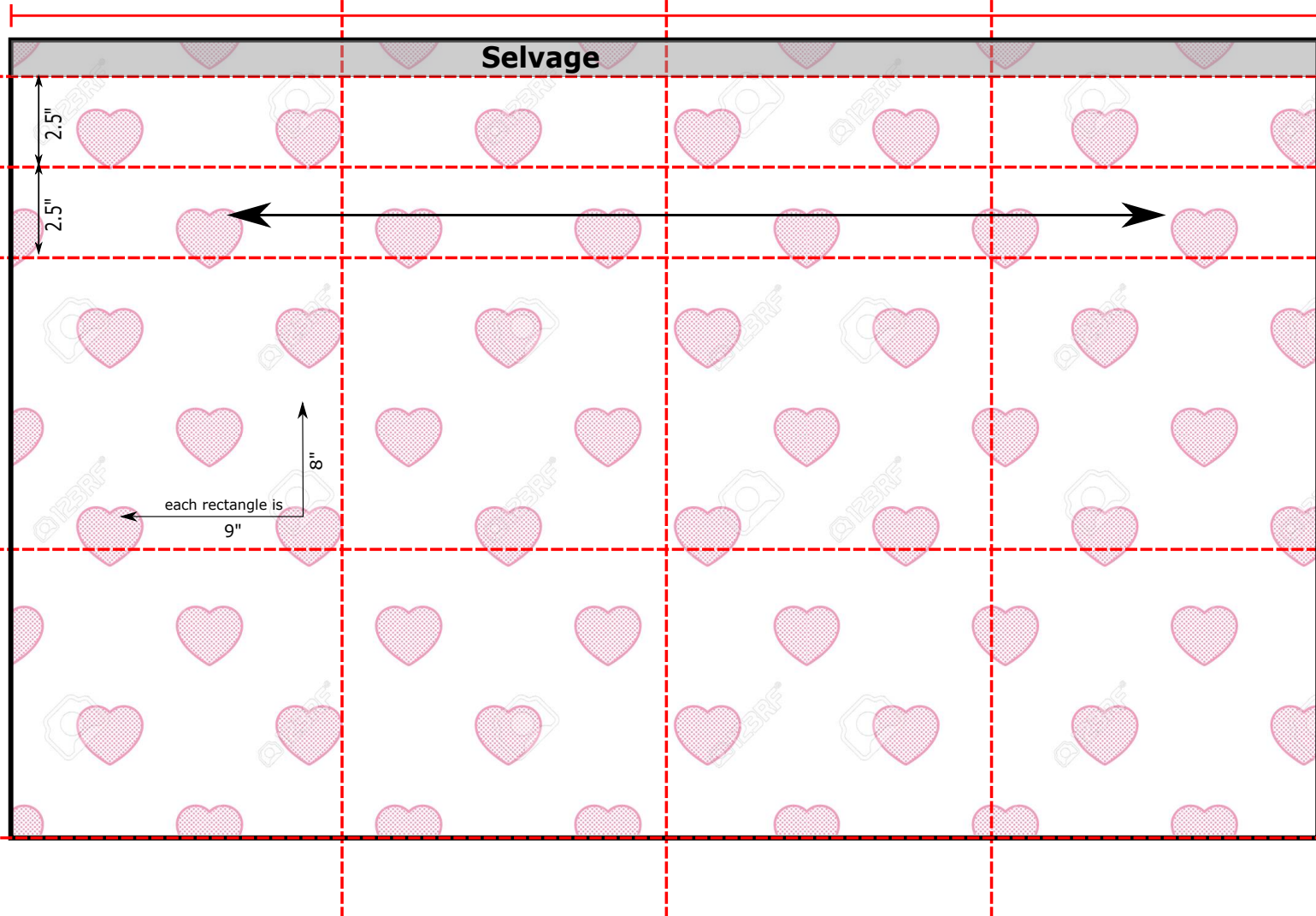
- **Check if your fabric has a print orientation before cutting!**

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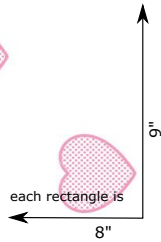
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
